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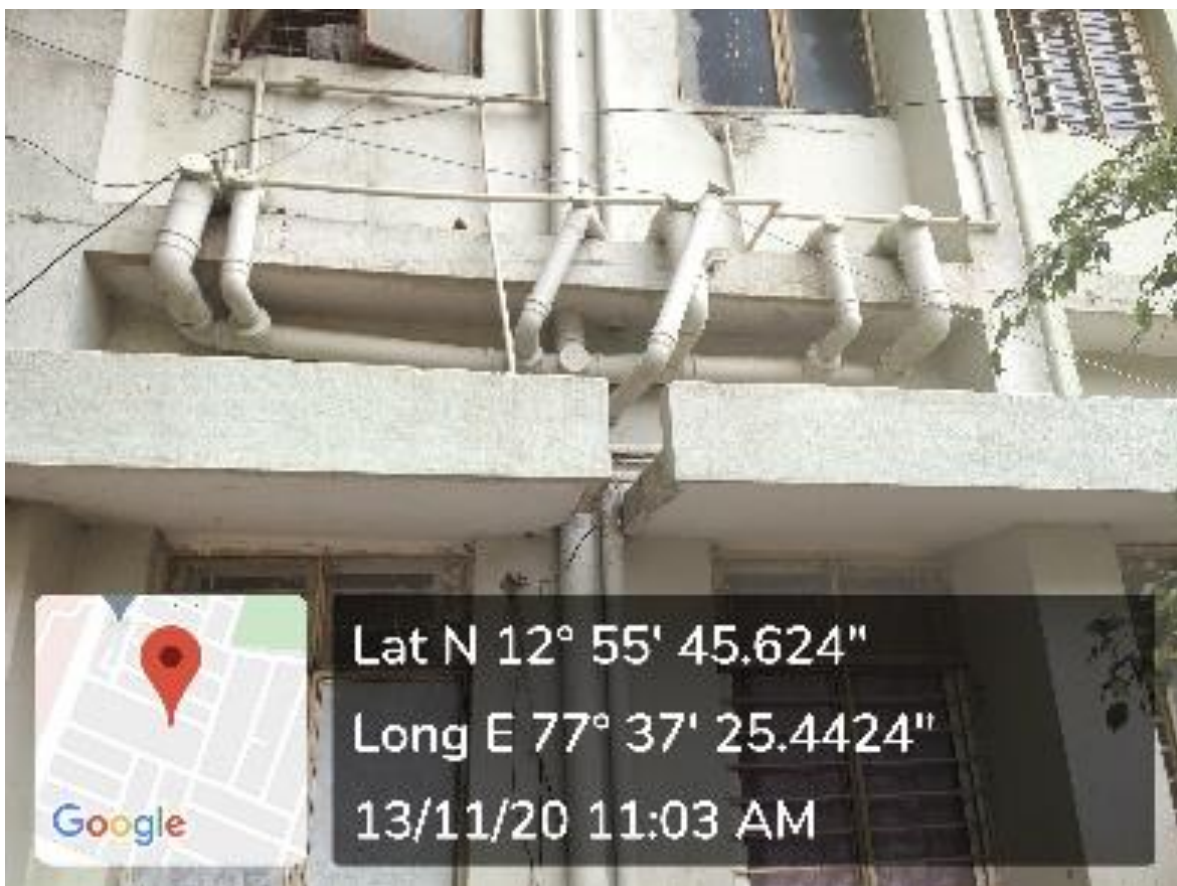

Sub No 2 : Regarding Enhancement of Service charges to M/s. Sri Venkateswara Enterprises towards shifting of Garbage from Koramangala Campus.

Note: M/s. Sri Venkateswara Enterprises have been entrusted the work of shifting of garbage from KRJS Koramangala Campus since 2016 at the cost of Rs. 10,000/- per month. In the year 2018 vide letter dated 14-12-2018 he has requested to enhance the service charges from Rs. 10,000 to 17000. No action has been taken on this request. Once again he has submitted written requisition on 31-1-2020 and requested to revise the services charges from Rs, 10,000 to Rs. 20,000.

Resolution: M/s. Sri Venkateswara Enterprises called for negotiation. After the negotiation it is decided to enhance the service charge for shifting of garbage from Rs. 10,000 to Rs. 15,000 with effect from 1-3-2020 as agreed upon by him.
